[CREATE]

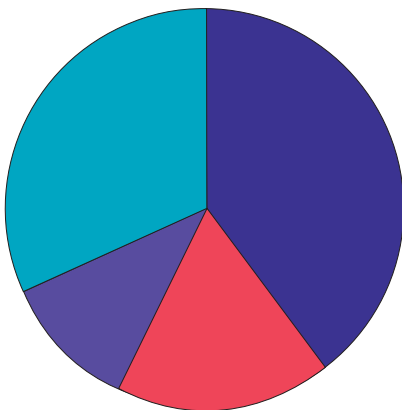
